

High Knob Resident Parking Policy

Adopted March 1, 2011

Parking at the front entrance is limited to residents only, whose vehicle must display a High Knob parking permit. They may be purchased at the High Knob office for \$5 for each vehicle.

Parking is limited for a period not to exceed 72 consecutive hours.

No double parking is allowed.

No parking is allowed on the east side of the road except for school drop-off or pick-up of students or under emergency conditions, i.e. snow and icy roads.

No parking of attached truck/car and trailer is allowed.

Parking contractor vehicles of any type, including trucks, trailers and other construction equipment is strictly prohibited.

Residents may occasionally park “small” commercial equipment for periods up to 24 hours.

Unoccupied motor homes and recreational trailers are allowed, however, all other rules apply.

Good judgment should be used regarding the length of time the parking lot is occupied during periods of inclement weather, particularly during icy and snowy conditions and other instances of high usage. When the lot is full, no additional vehicles shall be placed in the lot and those vehicles so placed shall be removed or towed.

Exceptions may be granted by the HKOAI staff.

It should be noted that commercial vehicles in excess of 10,000 pounds GVW are specifically prohibited by county ordinances.

Vehicles left in the parking area in violation of these rules will be towed at the owner’s expense.
