

2012 High Knob Pool Rules

Pool Passes for 2012:

\$20.00 per Adult (18 and older)

\$10.00 per child (2-17)

Free for children under the age of 2

Pool Registration with payment must be submitted to the High Knob Office, during regular business hours, before using the pool. Monitors will not be allowed to accept any registrations at the pool. Passes must be presented to the monitor to use the pool. If you do not have your pass with you, you will not be permitted to use the pool.

Pool passes will be issued for each family registering to use the pool. Passes will be issued and must be presented to the monitor at time of entry into the pool. **If your pass is lost or stolen, it can be replaced for a cost of \$5.00.** Passes will be available for pick up during regular pool hours by an adult family member who must show ID. Passes can be picked up at the pool starting May 26th.

There will be a \$2.00 per guest fee for guests using the pool for a day. This fee will be collected by the monitor and used for necessary upgrades that the pool may need.

RIGHT TO USE THE POOL

1. All members of the Association (or their designated tenants) IN GOOD STANDING, are entitled to use the pool after the Pool Registration is signed and returned to the HKOAI office together with the appropriate payment. The Board of Directors may suspend this privilege for members who are delinquent in their Sanitary District Fees and/or HKUI bills or other Association bills. A resident is anyone living on High Knob for at least one month at a time and who is stated on the pool registration form when submitted.
2. Guests will be charged \$2.00 per visit upon entry. **Guests must be escorted by an eligible pool user who is eighteen (18) years of age or older. Guests will not be admitted to the pool without such escort.** Eligible pool user escorting a guest MUST remain in the pool area with the guest. All guests must register with the pool monitor prior to entering the pool. The conduct of guests is the responsibility of the escort.

RULES FOR USE OF THE POOL

1. **Pool pass must be presented to the monitor for entry into the pool.**
2. The Association is represented by the monitor who has been instructed in the rules of the pool. Any conflicts shall be addressed with Office Personnel who will bring the issue to the Association Board of Directors if it cannot be satisfactorily resolved.
3. Failure of any member or guest to abide by the pool rules may result in the offender being asked by the monitor to take a time-out. If the behavior continues after three (3) time-outs, that

member will be asked to leave the pool for the remainder of the day. If non-compliance continues, a disciplinary letter will be sent to the member and the Board will determine the time of suspension deemed necessary.

4. The monitor has the authority to ask anyone to leave the pool area for infractions of the rules or when safety is threatened and may confiscate pool pass until the matter has been resolved.

Office personnel, upon written documentation, may prohibit entry to anyone for up to one week for each violation without prior authorization from the Board of Directors.

5. Children 6 years of age or younger must be accompanied to the bathrooms by an adult.
6. Safety is the primary concern of the Association and its members. All persons using the pool do so at their own risk and agree to abide by the rules for use of the pool. The Association assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use for any loss or damage to personal property. Residents (Members and tenants) are responsible for the actions of their children and their guests.
7. Children under eighteen (18) years of age must be accompanied by an adult. If the adult is not a resident, the name must be submitted to the office prior to use of the pool. (For example, if a grandparent is visiting and will be bringing children to the pool, the grandparent's name must be given to the office prior to use of the pool.)
8. No person shall use the pool facilities unless the pool is officially open and monitor is on duty. Unauthorized persons found inside the pool enclosure when the pool is closed will lose their privileges for the remainder of the pool season and risk prosecution for trespassing.
9. Persons who have obvious infections (colds, lesions, open sores, etc.) will not be allowed in the pool. Sanitary habits are a responsibility of everyone and anyone displaying improper behavior will be asked to leave the pool area.
10. No smoking is permitted in the pool area, including the bathhouses. An ashtray will be provided outside the pool area.
11. Glass objects are not permitted in the pool area.
12. Food and beverages (in unbreakable containers) are permitted in the pool area. It is the resident's responsibility to keep the pool area clean of food and trash. If you bring it, you take it home.
13. Intoxicants (alcohol or drugs) will not be allowed in the pool area at any time. Intoxicated persons will not be allowed in the pool area at any time.
14. Swimmers must wear proper bathing attire. NO cut-offs, dungarees or similar attire will be permitted. Children in regular diapers are NOT allowed in the pool. Please use appropriate "swimmy" diapers.
15. No play equipment or wheeled vehicles (except wheelchairs, strollers, etc.) are permitted in the pool area.
16. No pets (except service dogs) are permitted in the pool area.
17. Subject to the discretion of the monitor, instructional flotation devices may be used under the direct supervision of an adult. Flotation devices should be used with a modicum of common sense. Toys are **not** permitted in the pool such as, but not limited to, diving sticks, balls, Frisbees and water guns. Goggles (those that cover the eyes only) will be allowed in the pool. Life jackets & "swimmies" may be worn in the pool. At the discretion of pool personnel, masks made of

tempered safety glass may be used. Boogie Boards and large inflatable toys are **not** permitted in the pool. Noodles and inflatable rings which are of acceptable size are permitted. A display board is available to ensure measurements of an acceptable size.

18. Running, pushing, wrestling, dunking, standing or sitting on another's shoulders is NOT ALLOWED. No screaming, profanity or boisterous behavior will be permitted in the pool area.
19. Diving is permitted only from the deep end of the pool.
20. Swimmers shall remain clear of the ladders and steps except when entering or exiting the pool.
21. **The clubhouse side of the pool is reserved for lap swimming (a lane divide may be provided upon request of the swimmer).**
22. The pool may be closed at the discretion of the pool personnel in case of thunder, lightning, rain or operational breakdowns. If thunder is heard, all members and guest will be asked to get out of the pool for 15 minutes and consecutively every 15 minutes thereafter until the threat is gone.
23. The use of radios, televisions or similar devices is permitted only when used with headphones or so as not to disturb others.
24. Private, reserved use of the pool facility shall not be permitted during normal operation hours established by the Board of Directors. Any private, reserved use shall be permitted only if authorized by the Board of Directors in writing and in accordance with any rules and regulations. A High Knob pool monitor must be available and shall be paid directly by Lessee.
25. **ALL REFUSE MUST BE PLACED IN CONTAINERS PROVIDED FOR THE PURPOSE. KEEPING THE FACILITY CLEAN IS EVERYONE'S RESPONSIBILITY.**
26. An Adult swim will be held every Monday morning from 10:00 AM to 12:00 PM and Tuesday evening from 6:00 PM to 8:00 PM. Swimmers must be eighteen (18) years or older to participate.
27. Beginning at noon and every 2 hours (12, 2, 4 & 6 PM) a 15 minute break will be imposed to allow children to rest & use the rest rooms and to allow a 15 minute adult swim. However, at any time, an adult may ask the monitor to set up the lap lane.
